Addendum Summary:

Updates the prevailing wage rates for the 10-day federal requirement. The here referenced wages are to be used in this contract and will be physically incorporated into the final executed contract. This addendum also provides clarification on the request for product substitution for the ARAM component of the project along with other questions brought up the City's attention to date.

Changes:

Note: These are the project specific federal prevailing wage rates to be used for this project. These wages will be physically incorporated in the final contract. Contractor shall pay the higher of the federal and state wage for a given work classification. Refer to the contract documents for more information.

2. Asphalt-rubber substitution request.

The City of El Centro received a request to use warm applied asphalt-rubber binder as an equal to standard asphalt-rubber binder used in the ARAM process and specified in the contract specifications. The City has determined that not sufficient information has been submitted substantiating performance of the product and has denied the substitution request.

3. Q: On page 57 of the Specs the current Caltrans Section 39 Standard for asphalt concrete is supposed to apply. Is this correct or does the May 2006 standard apply?
A: May 2006 standard applies.
