CITY CLERK

CITY COUNCIL



The governing body of the El Centro municipal government. The Council adopts City ordinances, reviews and approves all major policy matters, fiscal proposals and City projects. It is composed of five elected Council members who serve four-year terms. The City Council selects a Council member each year to serve as Mayor for a one-year term.

Is the Chief Executive Officer of the City and Treasurer for the City and municipal hospital. This position is charged with implementing City Council policies and directives.
